- **Trees on Thames Water's land between Carpenters Gardens and Barrowell Green.**
This area is being enhanced. Notices showing what it will look like are displayed nearby. Trees have been removed before the nesting season began and will be replanted in November which will help them to establish.
- **Cycle Enfield**
 - Pedestrians have priority over cycles and bus stops
 - A decision is still being made about the armadillos which separate the cycle lane. A segregated cycle lane was required by TfL.
 - The stage 1 safety audit is available on the web site but not stage 2. This was published on the web site in early June (DB).
