1. JUBILEE WARD FORUM: ACTION NOTES

- Motorised vehicle in the ward – the police have been informed.

Action 1: Jubilee ward Councillors will continue to ask officers to take necessary enforcement action.

- Rubbish badly managed on Nathan Court

Action 2: Jubilee ward Councillors to report to council officers.

Action 3: Jubilee ward Councils to ensure that a site visit by Council officer to take place within the next few weeks.

- The toilets in Jubilee Park have been vandalised

Action 4: Jubilee ward Councillors to pick this up with council officers so that the toilets can be cleaned up ahead of the summer holidays.

- There is a lack of seating in Jubilee Park

Action 5: Jubilee ward Councillors to ask officers for an update on the use of the benches that were in the bowels club; and whether we can have more benches installed in the park.

- There have been a few occasions residents have had a BBQ in the park

Action 6: Jubilee ward Councillors to seek confirmation that BBQs are not permitted in the park and ask council officers to ensure residents aware.

- Cycle Enfield – Herford Road

Action 7: Jubilee ward Councillors to ensure that an email address is set up and residents who have signed up have been informed what the email address is.

Action 8: Jubilee ward Councillors to organise a second resident meeting focusing on Cycle Enfield. Meeting to be scheduled by the end of July.

- Installing a bus monitors at bus stops on the Herford Road
