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KD 2252 Based on the results of a public consultation exercise on proposals to introduce an area wide traffic management scheme in the Palmerston Road Area of Bowes Park, the report will seek the required approval to implement the proposed scheme. The proposals, which have been amended in response to the consultation comprise various traffic calming and management measures including one way roads, textured surfacing and raised entry treatments.
