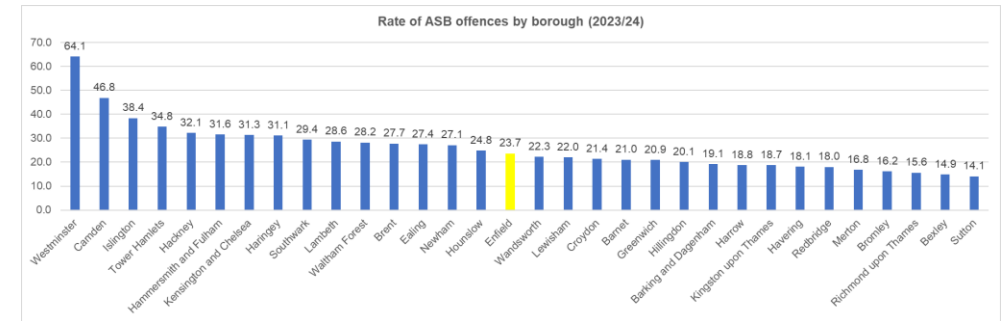
Dealing with Anti-Social Behaviour



There has been no significant change in the number of ASB offences between 2022/23 and 2023/24.

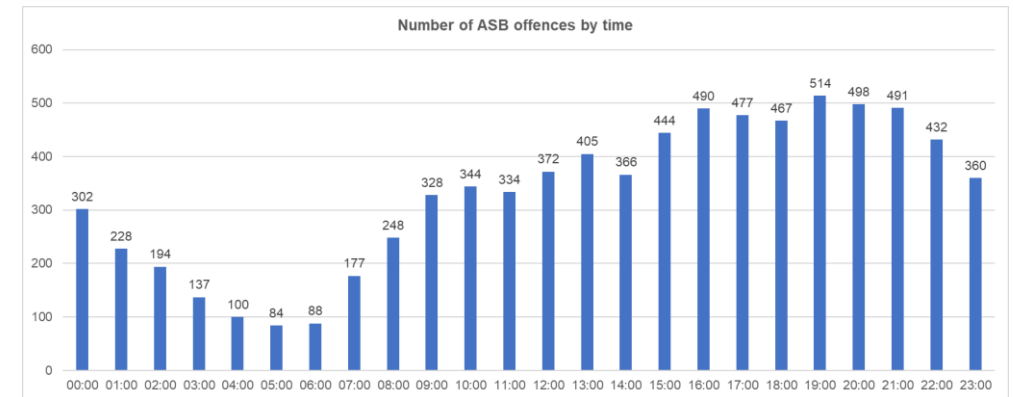
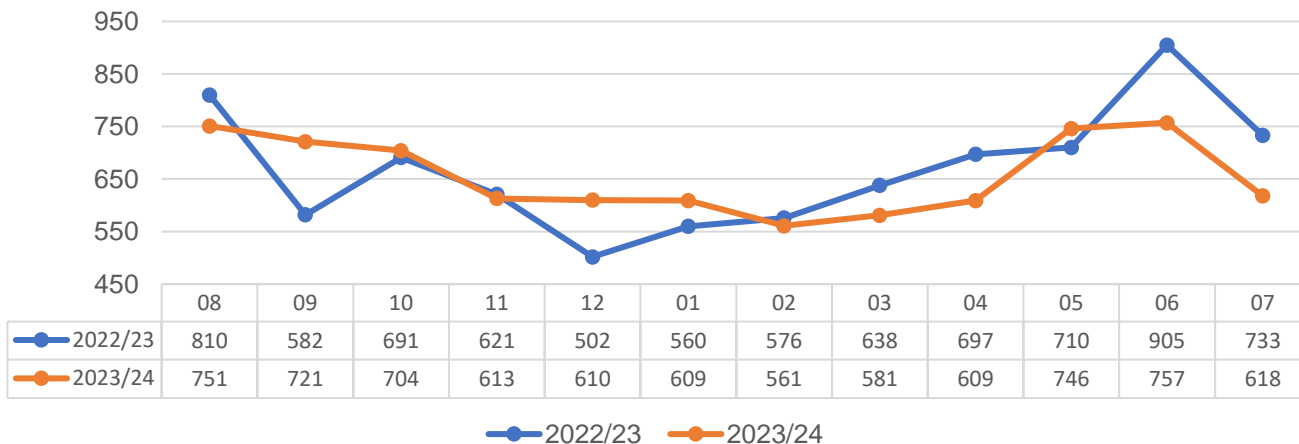
Enfield saw a 1.8% decrease in ASB offences from the year ending July 2024 compared to the previous 12 months. (8,028 offences in 2022/23 and 7,880 offences in 2023/24). London saw a 2.3% increase in ASB offences compared to previous year (221,089 offences in 2022/23 and 226,164 offences in 2023/24).

The highest number of ASB offences was reported in June 2023 (905 offences). This level of offences was not replicated in June 2024 with this month recording 757 ASB offences. However, both May and June 2024 do report higher levels of ASB offences compared to the other months in 2024. It is possible that the increased daylight hours and good weather in the summer months provides more opportunities for social gatherings which may contribute to the increase in reported ASB offences. Winter months report lower number of ASB offences and again this is likely to be affected by the weather and shorter daylight hours. July 2024 reported 618 ASB offences compared to 733 reported in July 2023, a decrease of 115 offences.



When considering the populations within each borough, Enfield ranks 16th highest for the rate of ASB offences when compared to the other London boroughs.

Number of ASB offences in Enfield by month



In Enfield, the number of reported ASB offences increases over the daytime with 7pm reporting the highest number of ASB offences (514). ASB offences are low during the night-time and early hours of the morning (1:00 AM to 7:00AM).

Priority 6: Drugs (Driver for violent crime)



Drug Offences

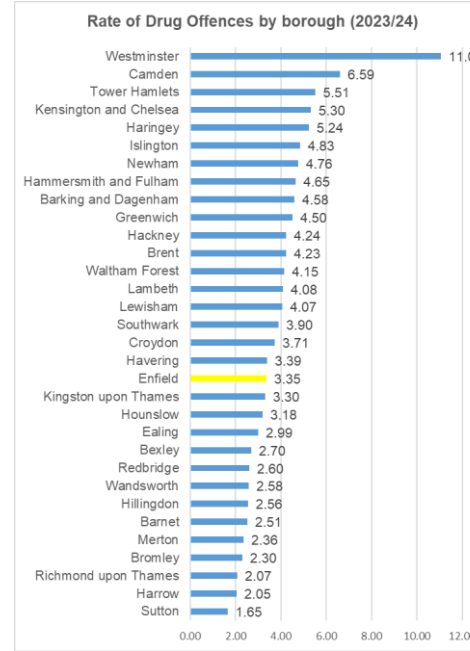
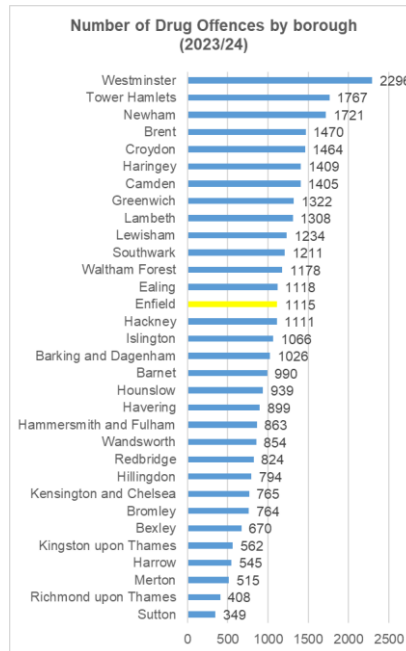
Drug Offences

Enfield has seen a 11.8% decrease in the number of drug offences similar to the decrease seen in London (15.3%).

For the year ending July 2024 there were 1,115 drug offences reported in Enfield compared to 1,264 offences in the previous 12 months.

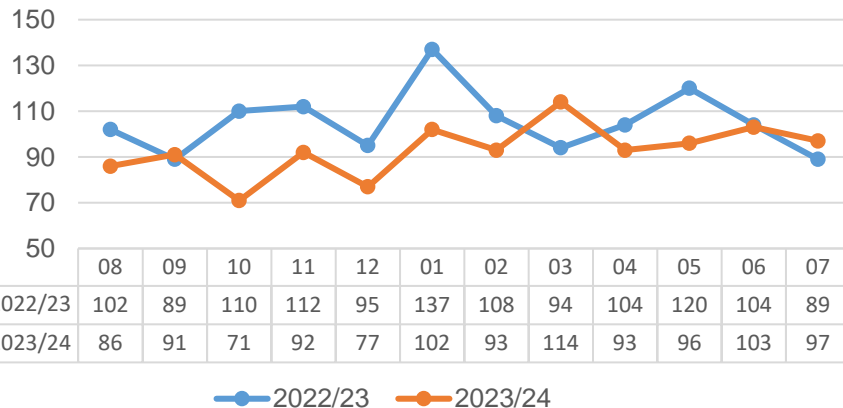
January 2023, saw the highest volume of drug offences with 137 incidents recorded. The number of drug offences reported in the winter months for 2023 are at a much lower volume than the same reporting period in 2022.

A possible reason for the lower volumes of drug offences in 2023/24 compared to 2022/23 is the change in the profile of drug users within the borough.

Number of Drug Offences by month



Enfield ranks 14th highest when comparing the volume of reported drug offences compared to the other 32 London boroughs.

However, when taking into account the populations within each borough, Enfield ranks 19th highest for the rate of drug offences when compared to the other London boroughs.

The table shows the percentage change of each ward for drug offences. Winchmore Hill reported the highest percentage increase (90.9%, 11 offences in 2022/23 to 21 offences in 2023/24) while Palmers Gren reported the biggest percentage decrease (54.5%).

Priority 7: Tackling Vehicle Crime

Vehicle offences



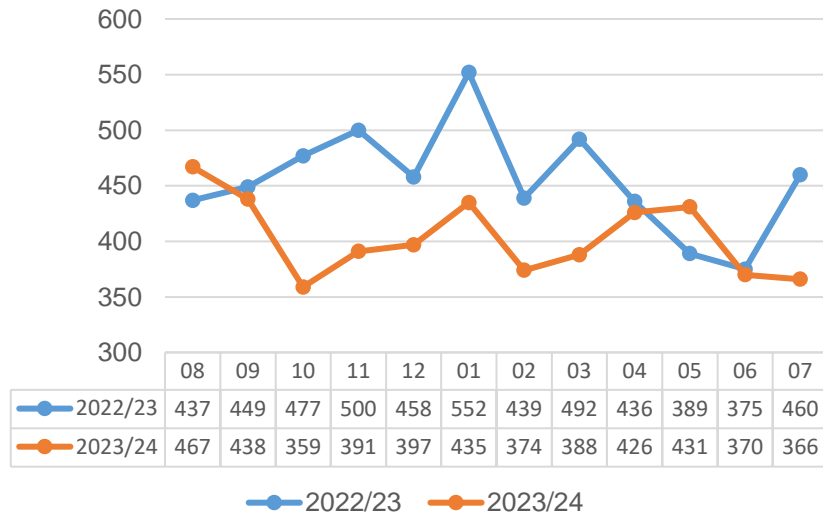
Vehicle Offences

Enfield has seen a 11.4% decrease in vehicle offences. London also saw a 3.1% decrease in vehicle offences during this period.

in the 12 months up to the year ending July 2024 Enfield reported 4,842 vehicle offences. This is 622 fewer than reported in the previous 12-months (5,464 offences).

January 2023 saw the highest level of vehicle offences with 552 offences. The volume of offences reported in the winter and spring months of 2023/24 are significantly lower than the number of offences reported in the same period in 2022/23.

The top 5 safer neighbourhood areas for vehicle offences in 2023/24 were: Upper Edmonton, Edmonton Green, Lower Edmonton, Brimsdown and Enfield Lock. Upper Edmonton reported 45 vehicle offences in November 2023. In July 2024, Edmonton Green reported the highest number of vehicle offences with 17 offences.

Domestic Abuse

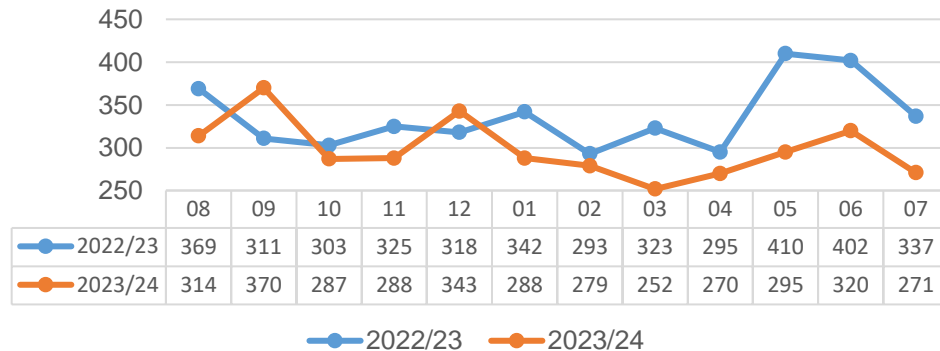
Enfield has seen an 11.2% decrease in the most recent 12-month period. This is similar to the decrease seen in London (8.3%).

There were 3,577 Domestic Abuse offences in Enfield in 2023/24, compared to 4,028 in the previous year.

May and June 2023 saw a significant rise in the number of reported domestic abuse incidents (410 and 402 offences respectively). This was not reflected in the same months in 2024. March 2024 reported the lowest volume of offences (252) a reduction of 71 cases when compared to March 2023. The volume of offences has steadily increased since March 2024 with June 2024 reporting 320 cases. July 2024 reported 271 offences.

Partnership challenge: what is the driver for the increase in domestic abuse cases between March and June 2024?

The top 5 safer neighbourhood areas were: Edmonton Green, Brimsdown, Enfield Lock, Lower Edmonton and Haselbury. September 2023 recorded 44 offences in Edmonton Green ward. June 2024 reported 34 offences in Enfield Lock. There were 26 offences recorded in July 2024 in Haselbury ward.

Domestic Abuse Incidents and Domestic Abuse VVI Offences



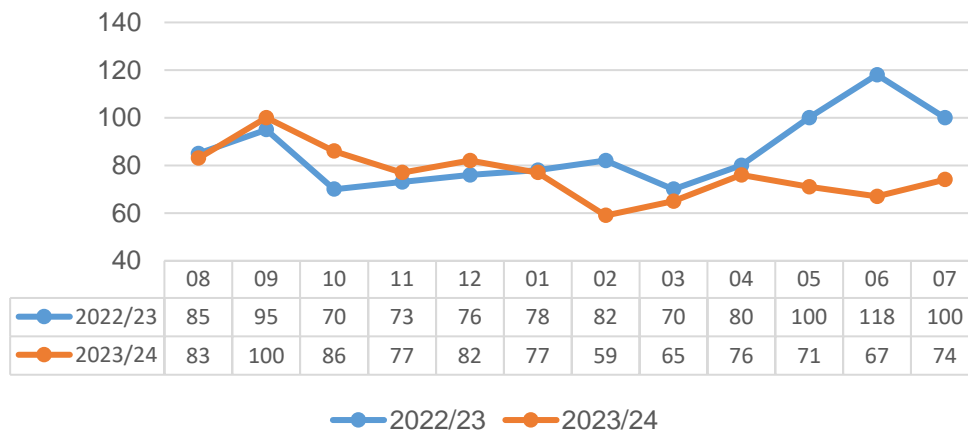
Domestic Abuse VVI Offences

Enfield saw a 10.7% decrease in domestic abuse violence with injury offences. London also saw a 6.5% decrease.

As with domestic abuse, the number of domestic abuse violence with injury offences increased in May and June 2023. This increase was not reflected in the same months in 2024.

The top 5 safer neighbourhood areas were: Haselbury, Brimsdown, Enfield Lock, Edmonton Green and Lower Edmonton. September 2023 saw a high level of domestic abuse violence with injury offences in Brimsdown, Enfield Lock and Edmonton Green with 15, 13 and 12 offences reported respectively. In December 2023, Lower Edmonton reported 12 offences. 12 offences were also reported in Enfield Lock in June 2024. In July 2024 9 offences were recorded in Bowes ward.

Sexual Offences and Rape Offences

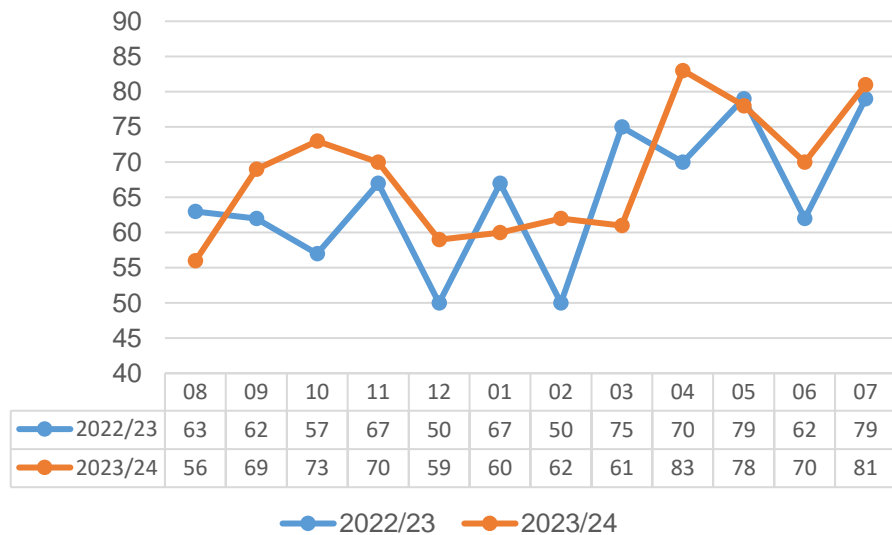
Sexual Offences

There was a 5.2% increase in sexual offences in Enfield. This is higher than the overall increase reported in London (0.6%).

In the period August 2023 to July 2024 there was 822 reported sexual offences in Enfield, an increase of 41 offences compared to the same period the previous year.

The highest number of sexual offences recorded in Enfield over the period August 2022 to July 2024 was in April 2024 with 83 offences.
