Joint Intermediate Care and Enablement Strategy Implementation Update May 2013

Significant progress was made in delivering the Strategy, including the development of several high-quality services to support the overall aims. However, the health and care landscape has changed since the development of the strategy; particularly the wider development of integrated care pathways across primary and secondary health and social care which seeks to better co-ordinate the overall support individuals receive.

It is proposed to review the strategy and its implementation to understand achievements and outcomes; assess the objectives of the strategy against the new landscape and consider whether there is a need make adjustments to the continued implementation 13/14.
