## Sheelpa Express, 389 Ordnance Road, Enfield, EN3 6HN - Licensing Act 2003

I write in relation to the premises licences that exist for the above premises.

On 1st February and 1st April 2011 Enfield Trading Standards, the Metropolitan Police and HM Revenue and Customs visited your premises and discovered that the premises was selling non duty paid alcohol. This is a criminal offence.

As a result of these visits and the discovery of illegal activities at the premises Enfield Trading Standards is considering reviewing the premises licence (LN/200900553). Trading Standards believe that additional conditions need to be added to the premises licence to strengthen the licensing objectives.

However, in considering any review application, the Council's Licensing Sub-Committee may choose to:

- revoke the licence:
- suspend the licence for up to three months;
- remove the DPS from the licence;
- exclude a licensable activity from the licence; and
- modify the conditions of the licence.

As an alternative to having your licence reviewed Trading Standards are prepared to offer you the opportunity to apply for a minor variation to voluntarily add conditions to the premises licence and / or to improve some of the current conditions.

Enclosed is a document showing suggested amendments to the conditions. The additional conditions are designed to help prevent crime and disorder associated with the sale of counterfeit and non-duty paid items on the premises in the future and to further support the licensing objectives.
