DECISION

AGREED: subject to no call-in being received, the following decisions will come into effect on Monday 17th August 2015:

- 1. To award the contract to Bidder A, as detailed in the Part Two Report.
- 2. To delegate authority to the Director of Regeneration and Environment to finalise and approve the terms of the contract.

ALTERNATIVE OPTIONS CONSIDERED:

- 1. A joint procurement with one or more neighbouring borough(s). However all the neighbouring boroughs are committed to using the North London Waste Authority contract for this service.
- 2. The North London Waste Authority has a contract in place for the reception and processing of recyclables which could have been used. However the current price associated with that contract is higher than currently paid by the Council and is expected to remain so.

REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATIONS:

To ensure compliance with the UK Supply Contracts Regulations, the maintenance and improvement of service levels, value for money and recycling and performance.
