#### **DECISION**

**AGREED:** subject to no call-in being received, the following decision will come into effect on Wednesday 16<sup>th</sup> July 2014:

- 1. That approval is given to the extension of the existing Highway Tree Maintenance Contract (G/MD330) for a further period of 6 months currently awarded to Gristwood and Toms, to enable completion of the re-tender exercise.
- 2. To align the new Enfield Tree Maintenance Contract with the start of the 2015/16 financial year.
- 3. To approve the sum mentioned in the Part 2 report for the additional 6 months period from 1<sup>st</sup> October 2014 until 31<sup>st</sup> March 2015.

## **ALTERNATIVE OPTIONS CONSIDERED:**

An alternative option is not to extend the existing contract and finishing on the 30<sup>th</sup> September 2014, but during the re-tendering exercise there will be no continuity in the service for tree maintenance.

# **REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATIONS:**

- 1. Extending the existing contract for a further 6 months to expire on the 31<sup>st</sup> March 2015, to enable the completion of the re-tendering exercise.
- 2. To align the new Enfield Tree Maintenance Contract with the start of the 2015/2016 financial year.
