With regard to the revenue budget for 2015/16 it is recommended that Council: Set the Council Tax Requirement for Enfield at £100.917m in 2015/16; Subject to final pupil count data, approve expenditure of £307.837m in 2015/16 for the schools' budget, funded from the Dedicated Schools' Grant: Set the Council Tax at Band D for Enfield's services for 2015/16 at £1,100.34 (para 8.1 of the report), there being no increase over the 2014/15 Council Tax; Approves the statutory calculations and resolutions set out in Appendix 10 of this Report. With regard to the Prudential Code and the Capital Programme it is recommended that Council: Notes the information regarding the requirements of the Prudential Code (section 9 of the report); Agrees the Approved Capital Programme for 2015/16 to 2018/19 as set out in Table 9 (appendix 9, of the report). Also notes the Indicative Capital Programme and it is recommended that Council agrees these indicative programmes be reviewed in the light of circumstances at the time; Agrees the Prudential Indicators, the Treasury Management Strategy, the Minimum Revenue Provision statement and the criteria for investments set out in Section 9 and Appendices 4 & 5 of the Report
