- 1. To note the rise and demand for places at the higher end of the Autistic Disorder Spectrum and associated costs.
- 2. To approve the Council's acquisition of the freehold interest in the land and buildings that form all of Minchenden School (as shown at appendix 1 of the report) which are owned by the Barnet and Southgate College on the terms detailed within the Part 2 report and further approves, subject to the approval of Council, the total acquisition budget also detailed within the Part 2 report and;
