Urgent Motion in the name of Councillor Alev Cazimoglu

"The Care Quality Commission (CQC) report published on the 6th July 2016 rates the Urgent and Emergency Service at North Middlesex Hospital as inadequate. This Council is seriously concerned to learn of the failings identified in the report; and of the CQC's statutory Warning Notice issued to the trust requiring it to improve the care of patients in the Emergency Department (ED) by 26th August 2016.

The CQC's latest report follows their comprehensive inspection of the Trust in June 2014, which rated the Medical Care and ED as Requires Improvement.

This Council notes that North Middlesex Hospital Accident & Emergency (A&E) is one of the busiest Emergency Departments in London, serving a very deprived area with significant health needs. The Trust is under considerable strain, compounded by the financial underfunding of Enfield CCG; the lack of primary healthcare provision in Enfield; and government cuts to NHS services across the board.

This Council calls on the Secretary of State to urgently intervene to save our local hospital. The Secretary of State should ensure the Trust is adequately funded and supported in providing local people with safe, high quality services. We call on the Secretary of the State to guarantee the future of all current services at the hospital, including a fully functioning A&E department."

DECISION:

Agreed:

- 1. To approve the final terms of the sale and to authorise the Authorised Legal Officers, to enter into the Agreement for Sale in accordance with the Sale Contract and all associated legal documents (appended to Part 2 of the report).
- 2. To authorise all necessary expenditure associated with the purchase of this land as detailed in Part 2 of this report, noting that it will be contained within the existing approved capital budget.

ALTERNATIVE OPTIONS CONSIDERED:

REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATIONS:

- 1. The acquisition of the site will enable the council to exercise control over the land within the Meridian Water Masterplan area, which will help accelerate housing delivery.
- 2. To provide a greater level of certainty over the timescales associated with the development of Meridian Water and to increase developer and stakeholder confidence in the delivery of the Masterplan.
- 3. The purchase of the site will underpin the delivery of the Meridian Water Housing Zone and this land could support a mixed use development at a later date.
- 4. The land is being acquired with operational leases and tenants on site, the Council will be able to earn an income (c. £445k per annum) pending the time the land will be developed therefore the meanwhile use is activated immediately.
- 5. Further alternative recommendations are provided in Part 2 of the report.
