1. To approve and sign the Pan London contract for the next three years with an option of a one year extension, subject to satisfactory performance. The contract commencement date is subject to agreement on legal technicalities.

ALTERNATIVE OPTIONS CONSIDERED:

Not to participate in the Pan London contract. This was rejected due to lack of savings opportunities.

REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATIONS:

It would be prudent to join the Pan London contract to achieve the current postage values which will increase by 20 pence per item if we are not part of this group.
