## **DECISION**

AGREED, subject to no Call-in being received:

- 1. To note that the recommendations below are subject to the demonstration of overall viability of the Meridian Water scheme. Cabinet agreed that authority to approve the overall viability be delegated to the Cabinet Member for Economic Regeneration and Business Development and the Cabinet Member for Finance and Efficiency in consultation with the Executive Director of Regeneration and Environment and Executive Director of Finance, Resources and Customer Services. Subject to confirmation of overall viability the following was agreed:
- 2. To approve the terms of the sale as set out in the Agreement for Sale and associated legal documents (appended to Part 2 of the report) for the purchase of two sites in the east of Meridian Water Regeneration Area: a 10 hectare (24.5 acre) site known as Stonehill Estate (Stonehill) and a 3 hectare (c. 7.3 acres) site known as Hastingwood Estate (Hastingwood) (the sites). Complete the acquisition in accordance with the terms set out in the Agreement for Sale and associated legal documents (Appended to Part 2 of the report) and subject to approval of overall viability of the Meridian Water scheme.
- 3. To authorise the Assistant Director Legal and Governance in consultation with the Assistant Director for Regeneration and Planning, and the Assistant Director for Property to complete the legal requirements to enable entering into the Conditional Agreement for Sale and exchange and complete contracts subject to approval of overall viability of the Meridian Water scheme.
- 4. To note that the recommendations for approval of all expenditure associated with the purchase of the Sites were detailed in Part 2 of the report.
- 5. The recommendations in the part two report, containing exempt information, including a recommendation to full Council that the existing capital funding allocation for the Meridian Water programme be re-profiled to accommodate the immediate requirement and an additional capital fund be made available to the 2017/18 capital programme to support the acquisition.
