Events at Trent Country Park (TCP)

Following my letter of the 18th December 2015, where I set out the outcome of the review of large events at TCP, I am writing to inform you that the Council has received an application from the organisers (Found) of the 51st State event for a second event day. The Council will deal with this request as per the agreed policy framework set out within the Events Guidance Document 2012-17 www.enfield.gov.uk/download/downloads/id/8128/event guidance doc.

To uphold our commitment of improved communication between the Council and our key stakeholders, I am writing to inform you that a 28 day consultation will commence on Monday 11th January in line with the procedure for dealing with new large-scale event applications.

Consistent with 2015, Found have confirmed their intention to return to TCP in August, and we have agreed that this event will take place on Saturday 6th August, subject to a successful licencing application. As outlined within my previous correspondents, the Council has committed to no more than two large-scale event weekends over the summer holidays and should the second event day go ahead, then this would form one of these two weekends.

We are aware of the issues raised during the first year's delivery of the 51st State event, and this resulted in the commitment from Cllr Anderson to review large-scale events within the park.

Through the review it was agreed that the Council would take control of event related traffic management and street cleansing, which were two key concerns

raised through the review. In addition should it be agreed that the second event day will go ahead, the Council will also work with the event organiser to ensure the minimal amount of impact is made to the park and the surrounding areas.

Finally, as agreed through the review, I am proposing to hold the first meeting of the Trent Country Park Stakeholder Group in late January (date to be confirmed) where this and any other events proposed for the park can be discussed in greater detail.
