**WITHIN TWENTY EIGHT DAYS FROM THE DATE OF THIS NOTICE**

Petitions shall state on each page, the grounds for representation and notice to signatories that the petition will be copied to the applicant. Each page must be dated and signatories must print their full name and address.

*On the day after the application is made, this completed notice must be exhibited on a conspicuous part of the premises where it can easily be seen and read by persons in the street, 24 hours a day.*

*The notice must be kept exhibited for not less than 28 consecutive days.*

It is an offence to make a false statement in connection with an application and a person guilty of an offence is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level five on the standard scale.

### Licensing Act 2003 : Premises Licences and Club Certificates

#### Representation must be relevant.

Residents and businesses in the vicinity of the premises ("interested parties") are able to make relevant representations about any application for new or for variations to licences. This gives the local community a greater say in licensing decisions.

For a representation to be relevant it must be one that is about the likely effect of the application on the promotion of the four licensing objectives. Also, if the representation is made by an interested party it will not be relevant if the licensing authority considers it to be vexatious or frivolous.

The four licensing objectives that your representation must relate to are:

- the prevention of crime and disorder
- public safety
- the prevention of public nuisance
- the protection of children from harm

#### How to have your say

1. Select the Licence Register option
2. Find the Application you wish to make representations on
3. Select the Representation option and make your relevant representatio
4. Representations are allowed for a 28 day period following acceptance of the application

The **representation** facility will only be active during this period

Access is also available to more information via DCMS (Department of Culture, Media and Sport) website. This includes information on representations and reviews. Where a Premises Licence or Club Certificate has been granted, interested parties and responsible bodies can request the review of that licence.
