## **Conditions for Indian Fusion**

## Annex 1 - Mandatory Conditions

The Mandatory Conditions are attached and form part of the Operating Schedule of your licence/certificate. You must ensure that the operation of the licensed premises complies with the attached Mandatory Conditions as well as the Conditions in Annex 2 and Annex 3 (if applicable). Failure to do this can lead to prosecution or review of the licence.

Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule

1. There shall be no adult entertainment or services, activities or matters ancillary to the use of the premises that may give rise to concern in respect of children.

## CONDITIONS SOUGHT BY LICENSING AUTHORITY IF GRANTED IN FULL OR PART:

- 2. Prominent, clear and legible notices shall be displayed at all public exits from the premises requesting customers respect the needs of local residents and leave the premises and area quietly. These notices shall be positioned at eye level and in a location where those leaving the premises can read them.
- 3. Children under the age of 18 shall only be permitted in the premises if it shall be non-smoking throughout or alternatively only in a separate no smoking area of the premises which is physically separated from any smoking areas until such time as legislation is introduced to control smoking in public places, the exception being attendance at private functions e.g. family events such as weddings, birthday parties and for the collection of take-away food.
- 4. Signs shall be conspicuously displayed at all exits requesting patrons to consider local residents and leave the premises and the area quietly.
- 5. All staff shall receive induction and refresher training (at least every three months) relating to the times and conditions of the premises licence.
- 6. All training relating to the times and conditions of the premises licence shall be documented and records kept at the premises. These records shall be made available to the Police and/or Local Authority upon request and shall be kept for at least one year.
- 7. Staff shall ensure that the pavement from the building line to the kerb edge immediately outside the premises, including the gutter/channel at its junction with the kerb edge, is kept clean and free from litter at all material times to the satisfaction of the Licensing Authority.
- 8. Delivery drivers shall be instructed to conduct all deliveries in a quiet manner so as not to disturb local residents.
- 9. All delivery vehicles shall park at the front of the premises.

## CONDITIONS SOUGHT BY METROPOLITAN POLICE IF GRANTED IN FULL OR PART:

10. Payment for deliveries is made in advance - no monies shall be carried by individuals making deliveries.
