Meeting Minutes

Date: 2nd November 2016, 5:30pm

Venue: The Qube, 204 – 214 High Street, Ponders End, Enfield, Middlesex, EN3 4EZ

Attendees: Alan Hendle (AH), Laurie Bradford (LB), Lin Marsh (LM),

Vivienne Nicholas (VN), Maria Swords (MS), Dr Vaughan Watson (DrVW) [independent witness]

The meeting kicked off with attendees introducing themselves and outlined their involvement with Ponders End & District Smallholders Association Limited (PEDSA).

AH stated that everyone around the table were there because they all wanted the same thing which was to save the Association and to keep it from going under.

He said that he had made a number of observations about the Association and that he did not like the way that it was being run. He outlined his observations as:

- a) The Association was spending more money on expenses than it was bringing in and that drastic reductions in expenditure had to be made to safeguard the Associations long-term survival;
- b) The Association had made a gross error in judgement by allowing a member of staff to also sit on the committee as there was a conflict of interest when issues arose which affected that employees areas of responsibility;
- There were no control or checks in place within the Association relating to the overall operation of the Bar;
- d) The Association failed to tap into the knowledge and expertise of the Book Keeper on issues relating to Club, Employee and Licensing Law.

LM clarified that the Association holds monthly committee meetings and that throughout 2016 she has made it clear to committee members that the Association was in financial trouble. **LM** stated that she had asked committee members for ideas on how to get the Association out of its financial difficulties, but no one had offered up any solutions.

LM admitted that the entire committee members were weak on all matters concerning governance (*how to run a club*) and financial management. **LM** agreed that the Bar and Trading Hut had taken in less than the expenses they faced.

LM stated that contrary to rumours, the rent of £476.88 to Enfield is paid monthly on the first of the month. In fact a letter from Enfield stating that the Association had overpaid was displayed next to the Dartboard in the clubhouse. A further letter from Enfield dated 14th October 2016 which was presented to everyone around the table stated that the Association had made another overpayment.

VN questioned the validity of that letter as it did not state the sum which was overpaid.

LM clarified that she believes the overpayment amount could be between £13 to £14. And in future the rent would be paid by standing order.

VN stated everyone needed to see written proof from Enfield of the overpayment sum as at the moment it was all just hearsay.

LM commented that Enfield had received a number of anonymous phone calls from a member of the public stating that the Bar did not have prices displayed or weights and measures in place.

MS said that this was not true as she had worked behind the bar and when she did, prices for all products sold in the bar had been listed on the walls to the left and right of the bar.

LM added that Enfield had also received a complaint from a resident in Church Rd about Bonfires on the allotment and that the council had responded by sending her an email outlining that no bonfires could take place on the plots up until September.

LM stated that a number of plot-holders had said that they did not believe the copy of the email displayed on the gate was really from Enfield. **LM** said that all these complaints that Enfield received about the Association will go against them when they want to start negotiations to renew the lease, which she was informed by Enfield could start within the next few years.

VN asked for clarification as to why no action had been taken by the committee to attend the Financial Conduct Authority (FCA) hearing on the 4th June 2015, or responded to the Letter of Cancellation.

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LM said that neither she nor anyone on the committee understood who the FCA were or the implications. **LM** said that during 2016 she had tried to contact the FCA, but they would not speak to her.

VN stated that as LM had signed Accounts in previous years and had been involved with sending them off to the Industrial & Provident, had she really no idea that the FCA took over from them and that the Accounts needed to be sent off to them now?

LM replied that she did not have any idea. She took on the role of Secretary as no one else wanted to do it and cheques needed to be signed. All she wants to be involved with is organising events.

All the expenses for events put on during 2016 had come out of her own personal pocket, and that food and entrance to these events were free.

VN stated that despite the bad blood between certain plot-holders and associate members LM had to be praised for getting people through the door to attend all of these events which was her strength.

However, there was an overall lack of communication between plot-holders and associate members and a general sense of distrust of the committee.

VN highlighted a case in particular when LB and DrVW attended a meeting in August at the invitation of LM to view the FCA letters and were verbally abused by certain committee members present. DrVW was also pushed by the Chairman resulting in the police being called.

LM apologised for her and the committee members behaviour on that evening.

VN stated that the reason why a Special General Meeting was called on the 30th October 2016, was that an AGM had not taken place.

LM said that the reason why an AGM had not taken place was that the Accountant had not been paid to do the accounts and that he will be paid by cheque so an AGM could take place within the next few weeks.

AH stated that the Accountant had made some recommendations on how to move forward and that they must preserve the committee. **AH** said that a recommendation was to have at least two Plot-holders and two Associate members on the committee.

VN highlighted that two resolutions had been passed at the Special General Meeting:

1. A vote of no confidence in the committee;

To put in place an interim supervisory board to investigate the governance (running), financial management of the Association and oversight of any elected committees.

VN presented the resolutions and AH questioned the legitimacy of the resolutions.

DrVW informed the group that according to the Associations constitution (rules) the mandate (*authority to act on behalf of the Association*) of the existing committee ran out one minute past mid-night on Monday the 24th October 2016 as the last AGM was held on 25th October 2015 and the Association failed to hold an AGM for 2016 to elect new officers for 2016/2017.

DrVW read out the resolutions and after doing so asked if everyone understood them.

Everyone said that they understood.

DrVW said that the resolutions voted for by sixty-five members were now legal instruments. He asked **LM** that did she accept the resolutions to which she replied she did.

DrVW also informed the group that the Association had no management in place until an AGM was held to elect the new officers for 2016/2017.

[Legally, since 25th October 2016, LM has no authority issuing cheques on behalf of the Association, until such time as she is re-elected or co-opted (brought in by the committee) to do the role.

In the same way since 25th October 2016, the Accountant or Book Keeper has no authority handling the Accounts of the Association, until such time they have been nominated and voted or co-opted (brought in by the committee) to do the role.]

VN asked LM if the Association had any money to meet its expenses commitment.

LM replied that the Association at this time had no money.

VN asked LM how much money does the Association owe and to whom.

LM replied that the Book Keeper has the details, but there is a personal loan on behalf of the Association with Green King which she and Del Barnard stand as guarantors.

VN informed LM that she should not have done that as it wasn't agreed by the members.

LB asked if the bar has dealings with Hills Prospect for drinks?

LM confirmed that the bar buys drinks from Hills Prospect.

LB said that the bar should not be doing that as she believes the agreement with Green King is an exclusive one.

LM agreed that this should not have happened but it was the Bar Steward who had put this in place without being authorised to.

VN asked LM was she aware that the HMRC had paid the Association a visit and that within the next eight days they would come back to start proceeding to recover money owed. They will look at the accounts, see that there is no money and seize the Association assets. If the FCA has cancelled PEDSA's membership, the limited liability protection offered by being part of the FCA is cancelled too. What this means is once the HMRC finds that the sum total of the Association assets cannot pay off the money owed, they could go after all each and every member to ask them to contribute paying off the sum owed.

LM, AH and MS all said they were not aware of the implications.

AH stated that when you take an "X" report, you "Read" the cash registers information. You can take these reports while you're open for business and you can look at your sales totals at any time of the day. So "X" reports can be run whenever you want to throughout the day.

On the other hand, when you take a "Z" report, you're "Resetting" the cash registers information. All of your sales totals will be "Reset" back to zero. Typically, when your business closes for the day you'll run your "Z" reports to get your sales totals for the day.

The Bar Steward does not take any reports.

VN asked was there an Employee Contract for the Bar Steward and accounting documents that she could inspect.

LM stated that the accounting documents and Employee Contracts were at 82a Church Rd.

VN asked **LM** if she could get them after the meeting to which **LM** replied that the Bar Steward may prevent them from doing that. **VN** said would he do that even after being shown a copy of the resolution?

DrVW suggested that perhaps both **AH** and **VN** accompany **LM** to retrieve the necessary documents after the meeting. It was agreed that this is what would happen.

LM stated that Monday is the day the weeks banking for the Association is done, with top copy sheets going to the Book Keeper.

AH said that during the meeting we keep on referring to the Book Keeper shouldn't that be Treasurer?

VN informed the group that the Association has no Treasurer as he resigned from that role and now only performs Book Keeping duties.

AH asked what should be the next step.

VN said that LM needed to phone the Book Keeper to say that he had the authority to give VN access to all the accounts and to set up a meeting with both AH and herself to retrieve them. LM took out her phone and left a message for the Book Keeper which went to voicemail. LM asked the Book Keeper to call AH to arrange a time and place for that meeting

VN said that LM with the assistance of AH needed to email or write to the FCA and propose a payment plan of possibly £150 per month to pay off the fine.

AH asked if the group could have a follow up meeting once **VN** has had time to analyse the accounts.

It was agreed that the group would meet Monday 7th November at Vincent House to come up with an action plan.

The meeting concluded and **AH**, **LM** and **VN** arranged to meet later, 8pm 82a Church Rd to pick up accounting documentation and Employee Contracts.

An addendum to the minutes of the meeting held on 2nd November 2016

AH and VN met LM at the clubhouse to collect accounting documentation and the employee's contract. LM said that she did not have an office but there was an office being prepared for future use in one the huts. No documentation was surrendered for collection.

LM and Colin Corbett confirmed that Sean Bolton had been given all the invoices to be paid earlier on in the day. VN asked if there were any more invoices that Sean had not taken.

Colin said there were a couple that he held back as they were required for the next stock take which is due on Tuesday 8th November 2016.

It was agreed that Colin would prepare a list of those invoices for **VN** to collect the next day at 12pm as this information is urgently needed to be included in the total balance of outstanding payments. Colin stated that these invoices are paid by Direct Debit.

LM was asked by VN to see the letter from HMRC to determine when they would visit to seize the associations' assets. LM stated that the letter was at her home. LM agreed to phone them to find out the state of play.

It is to be noted that Traci Dawson, Ricky Kemp and Phillip Nicholas (as an independent witness) was also in attendance during the discussions.

Thursday 3rd November

VN was given a list of outstanding invoices totalling £ 3,329.68 from Hills Prospect showing the due date for payment. Lewis Corbett signed on Colin's behalf to attest that these were the only outstanding invoices as at 3rd November 2016. Thursday is Colin's day off.

Special General Meeting Minutes

Date: Sunday 30th October 2016, 10:30am

Venue: The Clubhouse

Members arrived at the clubhouse prior to 10.30 to hold a Special General Meeting as notified to the Committee. Names of those present with their plot number and signature were recorded.

Entry to the clubhouse was refused by Colin.

Upon arrival of two Community Police Officers (as arranged by Laurie) it was explained why we were there and requested they speak to Colin to advise him it was our right as members to meet in the clubhouse.

The Police Officers were advised by Colin that he was the Caretaker of the building and it was at his discretion not to allow members access to the building.

The Police Officers were advised by Bill Haydes that Colin as an employee works for the members. One of the Police Officers corrected Bill by saying that Colin was actually employed by the committee.

Dr V Watson informed the Police Officer that the mandate of authority of the 2015/2016 committee expired on the 25th October 2016 under its constitution rules due to failure to hold an Annual General Meeting during 2016 in which new officers for 2016/2017 would have been elected. Dr V Watson also informed the Police Officer, that the last AGM was 25th October 2015.

We were advised by the Police Officers that it was then a civil matter and we would need to take action to evict the committee and the staff employed by them from the building as they had the right of tenure. In this respect the Officers were referring to The Criminal Law Act 1977 which made it an offence to threaten or use violence to enter a property where someone is present and opposes the entry. We would have to seek legal advice to remove the committee and the staff employed by then who are now squatters in the clubhouse, using an interim possession order (IPO) or making a claim for possession.

The Officers informed us that we can only apply for an IPO if it's been 28 days or less since we found out our property's been squatted.

Note: new legislation was introduced on 1st September 2012 in the form of Section 144 of the Legal Aid, Sentencing and Punishment of Offenders (LASPO) Act. An offence is now committed where:

- a person occupies a residential building having entered it as a trespasser;
- the person knows or ought to have known that he or she is a trespasser; and
- the person is living in the building or intends to live there for a period.

Vivienne and Dr V Watson (he confirmed who he was and why he was there) gave an explanation of the Association's current status and how serious our position is. A way forward for us as members was suggested to set up an Interim Supervisory Board to investigate, correct and improve the governance of the Association for the period covering 30th October 2016 to 30th June 2017. It was agreed there was no confidence in the current Committee and the way they have run the Association.

A vote of no confidence was proposed by Pat Youngs and seconded by James Messam. A show of hands was counted, noted and witnessed by Dr V Watson our independent advisor.

A vote was then proposed by Charles Benjamin for an Interim Supervisory Board to be set up, which was seconded by Peter Lucking, a show of hands was counted and recorded.

The interim supervisory board members:

Laurie Bradford, Pat Youngs, Bill Haydes, Vivienne Nicholas, Fay Bernard, James Messam, Winston Binns Dr Vaughan Watson (special advisor)

Members dispersed and left the site. After a short period Tracy (Colin's partner) entered the clubhouse and left a short time after.

During this time a plot holder (Alan) was advised of the problems encountered with the Committee and that Lin Marsh would not meet with members to discuss matters and that she should have called an AGM by now. Vivienne also made him aware that she had tried to gain information, as a new member, from Lin Marsh as to the rules of the Association. No relevant information was provided.

The plot holder Alan advised he would try to discuss matters with Lin as he thought she was approachable. He entered the clubhouse and appeared with two copies of the small red book of rules for Vivienne.

Addendum to meeting:

Maria (a previous bar person) arrived to set up the Halloween party that had been advertised for Saturday 30 October 2016. Dr Watson took this opportunity to enter the clubhouse behind her. There was a slight altercation with Colin pushing Maria aside to stop Dr Watson but he was successful in entering. Dr Watson opened the other door for the remainder of the members present to gain entry.

After a period of discussion between Vivienne and Colin in the clubhouse he agreed to talk on Monday 31 October 2016 with her. He stressed he would only talk to Vivienne and Phillip.

It became evident that Lin would not appear; therefore we left the clubhouse and ended our meeting. Approximate time 12.30 p.m.





PONDERS END & DISTRICT SMALLHOLDERS ASSOCIATION SPECIAL GENERAL MEETING 4th MARCH 2017 REPORT

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INTRODUCTION

A number of members of the Ponders End & District Smallholders Association (hereinafter referred to as PESDA), having become increasingly concerned at what they perceived to be the gross mismanagement of the Association, approached Sir Henry Boyle of The Business Support Group (TBSG) in September 2016 to seek independent advice in the correct procedure for calling the PEDSA Officers to account.

Having met with some of these members during which meeting he was briefed, Sir Henry advised that the PEDSA rules should be followed in that members should formally request that an Annual General Meeting (AGM) be held and, if the Officers did not comply with their statutory duty to call an AGM, the PEDSA Rules made provision for members to call a Special General Meeting themselves.

No AGM was called and members then attempted to call an SGM in October 2016 although in Sir Henry's later opinion due process was not followed.





BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The last official AGM of PEDSA took place on the 24th of October 2015. The Association Rules (Section VIII – General Meetings – Rule 19) states that 'The Annual General Meeting, at which the audited accounts shall be submitted and the officers for the ensuing year elected ... ', which clearly confirms that, unsurprisingly, AGM's should be held every twelve months and financial accounts should be presented at each AGM for approval by members.

Many organisations do not hold AGM's exactly twelve months to the day from the previous AGM and it is *de facto*, if not *de jure*, practice to hold them within a week of such a date in order to take account of such matters as Public Holidays, severe weather conditions, industrial action and like matters.

Despite verbal requests to the Officers elected on 24th October 2015 no date was set for the October 2016 AGM, nor were any audited accounts circulated, nor was any explanation forthcoming concerning the apparent financial malpractice that had resulted in PEDSA being fined by the Financial Conduct Authority for repeated failures to make annual returns, which is a serious breach of a statutory requirement.

A number of members attempted to call a SGM for the end of October 2016 and an 'Interim Supervisory Board' (ISB) was established. This was a well-meaning attempt by some concerned members to help to return PEDSA to statutory compliance but, unfortunately, the Association's rules were not properly followed; this was confirmed by Sir Henry Boyle when he was again consulted on the 23rd of January 2017.

Having reviewed the PEDSA rules, Sir Henry gave independent guidance on the correct procedure for members to follow if they wished to assist PEDSA in returning to compliance.

Notwithstanding that as a result of no AGM having taken place in October 2016 there was technically no Management Committee any longer in place, Sir Henry suggested that members make one final attempt to force the ex-officers to call an AGM. A letter was drafted and signed by five members, which was then sent to the registered PEDSA address. A copy of this letter, dated 2nd February 2017, is shown on page 3 of this document.

THE SPECIAL GENERAL MEETING

No reply to the letter of 2nd February 2017 requesting the holding of an AGM was received by the signatories. In consequence of this, and in accordance with Section VIII – General Meetings of the PEDSA rules, a letter calling a Special General Meeting was sent to Mr. D Barnard, senior officer of the now-defunct Management Committee. This letter was sent to on 19th February 2017 and a copy is included at page 5 of this report. A further copy of this letter was sent to Mr. Barnard at the PEDSA registered office.

Without the co-operation of the ex-Committee, the members calling the SGM made every effort to contact all PEDSA members by posting notices in the Club House (which notices quickly and mysteriously disappeared) and by creating and printing (at their personal expense) a flyer giving notice of the SGM. This flyer was distributed widely amongst members (a copy is shown on page 6 of this report).

Following advice from external sources, including the London Borough of Enfield, the members calling the SGM were advised to engage an independent external Chairperson to conduct the meeting and Sir Henry Boyle was once again approached; he agreed to chair the meeting.

The SGM was held at 4.00 pm on Saturday 4th March 2017 at The Qube, 204 – 214 High Street, Ponders End, EN3 4EZ. Sixty-one verified PEDSA members attended, all attendees membership cards being inspected at registration.

All members attending were issued with an information pack containing:

- An agenda (copy shown on page 7 of this report)
- A document containing an extract from the PEDSA rules, showing the sections which were subject to the SGM resolutions (shown on page 8)
- A document containing the SGM resolutions (shown on pages 9 & 10)
- A ballot form for election of Management Committee Officers (shown on page 11)

The results of the voting on the resolutions and the results of the ballot for the Management Committee Officers are shown on the abovementioned pages.

Section XXI -Amendment of Rules - Rule 45

Mode of amending Rules – The rules may be amended by resolution of a three-fourths majority of the members present or by proxy at a Special General Meeting. No amendment of rules is valid until registered.

Section VIII - General Meetings - Rule 24

- 1. Committee of Management The business of the Society shall
- 2. be conducted by a Committee of Management, which shall be elected
- 3. at the Annual General meeting. The General meeting shall determine
- 4. the number of members of which the committee shall consist. The
- 5. qualifications of the Committee men, their order of retirement and
- 6. eligibility for re-election and how casual vacancies in the Committee
- 7. shall be filled. There shall be a minimum of five and a maximum of

Section VIII - General Meetings - Rule 26

Committee of Management of the Club House – The business and management of the Club House shall be conducted by a Committee of Management subject to the provisions relating to election and otherwise as are contained in the previous subparagraph 24 hereof. A duly elected Committee of Management of the Club House shall have power to introduce and enforce any bye-laws relating to the Club House provide that such bye-laws are displayed in a prominent position in the Club House.

Section X – Officers

- 2. Registered Office The Registered Office of the Society shall be at Falcon Fields, Church Read , Ponders and in the London Borough of Enfield, MIDDLESEX ENR UNIV
- 3. Removal of Cifice In the event of any change in the situation of the registered office, notice of such change shall be sent within 14 days thereafter to the Registrar in manner and form prescribed by the Treasury Regulation.
- 4. Objects The objects of the Society shall be:-
- (1) To carry on the business of creating or promoting the creation of small holdings or allotments, and encouraging their proper cultivation, with power to acquire land from local authorities acting under the provisions of any act for the time being in force relating to small holdings or allotments, or from any other person or body; to adapt any land so acquired for small holdings or allotments, to acquire or erect dwelling houses or other buildings, or to execute any other improvements, and to let the land, houses and buildings to members of the Society.
 - (2) To carry on the business of wholesale and retail dealers in horticultural and agricultural requirements, dairy, farm and garden produce, eggs and poultry; and any other class of goods the Committee may direct; and any other trades, industries or

businesses which may seem calculated to conduce to the more profitable working of small holdings or allotments.

5. Powers - The Society shall have full power to do all things necessary or expedient for the accomplishment of its objects, including the power to deal in any way with land or buildings.

II. SHARES

- 6. Shares Shares shall be transferable, but not withdrawable. They shall be of the nominal value of £1, of which 5p shall be payable on application, and the remainder in such calls as the Committee may direct.
- 7. Calls Except for the purpose of making good any deficit in the rent or other charges payable by the Society in respect of land held by it, no call shall exceed 15p per share. At least three months must elapse between two consecutive calls, and at least two weeks' notice shall be given of the payment of any call.

III. MEMBERSHIP

- 8. Members The Society shall consist of the persons by whom the application for registration is signed and such other persons, societies or companies, as the Committee may admit.
- (i) Shares to be held by Members Individual members shall hold not more than one share.
 - (ii) Cossation of Membership a member shall cease to be a member in the following eventualities:
 - (a) the member's death; or
 - (b) the member's resignation; or
 - (c) the expulsion of the member under Rule 10; or
 - (d) where the member has been required to pay an annual subscription the non payment thereof for the period for 3 months after it has become due and notice duly given
 - (iii) Members may be required to pay an annual subscription not exceeding £10 as may be determined by members at a General Meeting.
- 10. Expulsion of Members A Special General Meeting, may, by a two-thirds majority expel any member upon a charge of conduct detrimental to the Society, provided the charge has been communicated to the member at least one calendar month prior to the date of the meeting. On expulsion a member shall forthwith transfer his shares to a person nominated or approved by the Committee on payment to such member of the value of his shares, but not more in any case than the amount paid up on such

IV. PROFITS

- 11(a). Division of Profits The payment of five per cent interest on the paid-up share capital shall be the first charge on the net profits arising from the general business of the Society under Rule 4, Sub-section (2), including the interest paid to the general account of the Society under Rule 11a, Sub-section (3). The balance of such net profits shall be allocated as follows:-
- (1) At least one half to the Reserve Fund until the said fund equals the share capital, and afterwards such proportion as the Annual Meeting shall decide.
- (2) Not less than five per cent to the workers employed by the Society at the time division takes place as a bonus proportionate to the wages earned by them respectively during the period to which the division relates.
- (3) The remainder shall be divided amongst the members as the members shall determine at a General Heeting.

IVA. SMALL HOLDINGS AND ALLOTMENTS SEPARATE ACCOUNT

- 11b. Small holdings and Allotments Separate Account A separate account shall be kept by the Society of all income and expenditure of the Society under Rule 4, Sub-section (1). The income shall be applicable as the Committee may determine for the following purposes and for no other purpose whether during the existence of the Society or on dissolution:-
- (1) For payment of the expenses of managing land, houses and buildings acquired or erected under the said Rule including payment of rent, rates, taxes and other like outgoings.
- (2) For payment of expenses of repairs or improvements from time to time made by the Society on such land, houses and buildings.
- (3) For payment to the general account of the Society of interest at the rate of five per cent per annum or 1% above the Barclay's Bank Plce Base Lending Rate on all capital expenditure by the Society on the acquisition or adaptation of such land, houses and buildings.
- (4) For recouping capital expenditure by the Society on improvement or adaptation of the land, houses and buildings within such period as is reasonable having regard to the probable duration of the improvement or work of adaptation.
- (5) For forming a Special Reserve Fund not exceeding one year's annual value of the land, houses and buildings, and so that such reserve fund shall be available for any purpose authorised by this Rule but for no other purpose.

- (6) For prizes for the encouragement of the proper cultivation of the land; and
- (7) For the benefit of the tenants generally in such manner as the Committee may determine.

Nothing in this rule shall be deemed to prohibit an arrangement between the Society and a tenant for the repayment of rebatement of part of the rent payable by him to the Society.

Nothing in this rule shall prejudice or affect any right or remedey of any creditor of the Society.

V. LOANS AND INVESTMENTS

- members or non-members. The Committee may obtain loans on such security and such terms of repayment as they may think fit, provided that the amount shall not exceed twice the then issued capital of the Society, and that the rate of interest shall not exceed five per cent., or (if the Barclays lending Bank base rate is more than four per cent) one per cent above the Barclays Bank Plc base lending rate. Subject to the same condition as to the rate of interest, a General Meeting may authorise the Committee to obtain loans to a further amount, provided that the total amount of the loans shall not exceed five times the issued share capital.
- 13. Investments The Committee may invest any funds of the Society in any security authorised by the Section 31 of Industrial & Provident Societies Act 1965.

VI. TRANSFERS

- 14. Committee's consent to Transfers No transfer of shares shall be valid unless the Committee's consent has been obtained thereto, and the transfer is made in the form provided in Rule 16. A non-member to whom the shares are transferred with the Committee's consent shall thereby become a member of the Society, provided he holds a sufficient number of shares to qualify for membership in accordance with Rule 9.
- 15. Share Register A share register shall be kept in which shall be recorded the name of the person to whom each share was originally allotted and the date of allotment; if the share is transferred, the name of the person to whom it is transferred and the date of transfer; and of the share if cancelled, date of cancelling.
- 16. Form of Transfer Every Transfer of shares shall be in the following form, or as near thereto as is practicable:-

17. Fee on Transfers - A fee of £1 shall be paid to the Society on every transfer of shares.

VII. REPAYMENT OF SHARES

18. Repayment by Request - The Committee may, on the application of a member, in case of distresser removal from the district or for other good reason, repay to him a sum not exceeding the amount paid up and cancel the share.

VIII. GENERAL MEETINGS

- 19. Ordinary General Meetings TheAnnual General Meetings, at which the audited accounts shall be submitted and the officers for the ensuing year elected, and other Ordinary General Meetings shall be held at such times as the Committee or a General Meeting shall determine.
- 20. Special General Meetings Special General Meetings may be held at such times as the Committee or a General Meeting may determine, and shall be held upon the requisition in writing of at least five members.
- 21. Notice of General Meetings At least seven days notice shall be given of every General Meeting.
- 22. Voting at General Meetings At General Meetings each member shall have one vote. Members who are not tenants shall not have the right to vote on questions affecting tenant members only.
- 33. Quorum at General Meeting Unless otherwise determined by a previous General Meeting, a quorum at General Meetings shall consist of five members.
- 24. Committee of Management The business of the Society shall be conducted by a Committee of Management, which shall be elected at the Annual General Meeting. The General Meeting shall determine the number of members of which the Committee shall consist. The qualifications of Committee men, their order of retirement and eligibility for re-election and how casual vacancies in the Committee shall be filled. There shall be a minimum of five and a maximum of ten committee men who shall have been members of the Society for not less than two years and who shall retire and can offer themselves for re-election at each Annual General Meeting. To fill the vacancies the Committee shall nominate a sufficient number of members of the Club and a list of the names of those who retire as well as of those who are proposed to supply their places

shall be posted in the Club House seven days before such meeting. Any two members may propose any other candidate or candidates by notice in writing to the Secretary seven days at least before the meeting and the Secretary shall forthwith post the same. Every member of the club shall be entitled to vote for as many candidates as there are vacancies to be filled and no more. The candidates up to the number of vacancies who shall receive most votes shall be declared elected and in the case of two or more candidates receiving an equal number of votes there shall be a second election for the vacant position with just the two candidates standing

- 25. Quorum at Committee Meetings Unless otherwise determined by a General Meeting, a quorum at Committee Meetings shall consist of three members.
- 26. Committee of Management of Club House The business and management of the Club House shall be conducted by a Committee of Management subject to the provisions relating to election and otherwise as are contained in the previous sub-paragraph 24 hereof. A duly elected Committee of Management of the Club House shall have power to introduce and enforce any bye-laws relating to the Club House provided that such bye-laws are displayed in a prominent position in the Club House.
- 27. Special Meetings of the Committee A Special Meeting of the Committee shall be held on the requisition in writing of at least three Committeemen.
- 20. Committeemen becoming Surety Should any member of the Committee, with the consent of the Committee, become surety for any debt or liability incurred on behalf of the Society, he shall not be removed from office without his consent until such liability has ceased.

X. OFFICERS

- 29. Chairman The Chairman shall be elected by the Annual General Meeting and shall hold office for one year, but shall be eligible for re-election.
- 30. Auditors An Auditor, who is a qualified Auditor under Section 7 of the Friendly and Industrial and Provident Societies Act, 1968, shall be appointed each year by the Annual General Meeting.
- 31. Other Officers The Committee shall appoint and may remove a Secretary and such other officers as they may deem necessary and shall determine their respective duties and remuneration.
- 32. Security of Officers Every officer having charge of any of the moneys of the Society shall, before entering on his duties, give such security as the Committee shall deem sufficient.

XI. THE SEAD

- 13. Use of the Seal The Seal of the Society shall be a steel engraven one, and shall not be affixed to any document without the express authorisation of the Committee, and the affixing of the seal shall be attested by the signatures of two committeemen and the secretary.
- 34. Custody of the Seal The Seal shall be kept in the shall custody of the Secretary, or such other officer as the Committee shall duride

35. Use of Name - The registered name of the Society shall be kept painted or affixed on the outside of every office or place in which the business of the Society is carried on, in a conspicuous position, in letters easily legible, and shall be engraven in legible characters on its seal, and shall be mentioned in legible characters in all notices, advertisements, and other official publications of the Society, and in all bills of exchange, promissory notes, endorsements, cheques, and orders for money or goods, purporting to be signed by or on behalf of the Society, and in all bills of parcels invoices, receipts, and letters of credit of the Society.

XIII. AUDIT

- 36. a. There shall be appointed in each year of account a qualified auditor to audit the Society's accounts and balance sheet for that year. In this rule "qualified auditor" means a person who is a qualified auditor under Section 7 of the Friendly and Industrial and Provident Societies Act, 1968.
- b. None of the following persons shall be appointed as auditor of the society:
 - an officer or servant of the society;
 - ii. a person who is a partner of or in the employment of or who employs an officer or servant of the society; or
 - iii. a body corporate.
- c. Save as provided in paragraph (d) of this rule every appointment of an auditor shall be made by resolution of a general meeting of the society.
- d. The directors may appoint an auditor to fill any casual vacancy occurring between general meetings of the society.
- e. An Auditor appointed to adult the accounts and balance sheet of the society for the preceding year of account (whether by a general meeting or by the directors) shall be re-appointed as auditor of the society for the current year of account (whether or not any resolution expressly reappointing him has been passed) unless
 - i. a resolution has been passed at a General Meeting of the society appointing somebody instead of him or providing expressly that he shall not be reappointed or
 - ii. he has given to the society notice in writing of his unwillingness to be reappointed or
 - iii. he is not a qualified auditor or is a person mentioned in paragraph (b) of this rule or

iv. he has ceased to act as auditor of the society by reason of incapacity. Provided that a retiring auditor shall not be automatically reappointed if notice of an intended resolution to appoint another person in his place has been given in accordance with paragraph (f) of this rule and the resolution cannot be proceeded with because that other person is not a qualified auditor or is a person mentioned in paragraph (b) of this f. A resolution at a General Meeting of the Society i. appointing another person as auditor in place of a retiring auditor or ii. providing expressly that a retiring auditor shall not be reappointed shall not be effective unless notice of the intention to move it has been given to the society not less than 28 days before the meeting at which it is to be moved. On receipt by the society of notice of such an intended resolution at the same time and in the same manner as it gives notice in accordance with these rules of the meeting at which the resolution is to be moved or, if that is not practicable, by advertisement not less than 14 days before the said meeting in a newspaper circulating in the area in which the society conducts business. Where the retiring auditor makes any representations in writing to the society with respect to the intended resolution or notifies the society that he intends to make such representations the society shall notify the members accordingly as required by Section 6 of the Friendly and Industrial and Provident Societies Act, 1968.

The auditor shall in accordane with Section 9 of the Friendly and Industrial and Provident Societies Act, 1968, make a report to the society on the accounts examined by him and on the revenue account or accounts and the balance sheet of the society for the year of account in respect of which he is appointed.

XIV. ANNUAL RETURNS and BALANCE SHEET

- 37. (a) Every year not later than the date provided for in the 1965 Act the secretary shall send to the Registrar the annual return in the form prescribed by the Chief Registrar of Friendly Societies relating to its affairs for the period required by the 1965 Act to be included in the return together with:-
 - a copy of the report of the auditor on the Society's accounts for the period included in the return, and
 - ii. a copy of each balance sheet made during that

period and of the report of the auditor on that balance sheet.

The Society shall supply free of charge to every member or person interested in the funds of the Society on his application a copy of the last annual return of the society for the time being together with a copy of (the) report of the auditor on the accounts and balance sheet contained in the return.

The Society shall keep a copy of the last balance sheet for the time being together with the report made thereon by the auditor always hung up in a conspicuous place at the registered office.

XV. PROCEEDINGS ON DEATH OF A MEMBER

38. Upon a claim being made by the personal representative of a deceased member or the trustee in bankruptcy of a bankrupt member to any property in the Association belonging to the deceased or bankrupt member the Association shall transfer or pay such property to which the personal representative or trustee in bankruptcy has become entitled as the personal representative or trustee in bankruptcy may direct.

XVI. NOMINATIONS

- 39. (a) A member may in accordance with the Act nominate any person or persons to whom any of his property in the Association at the time of his death shall be transferred but such nomination shall only be valid to the extent of the amount for the time being provided in the Act.
- (b) On receiving satisfactory proof of death of a member who has made a nomination the Committee shall, in accordance with the Act, either transfer or pay the full value of the property comprised in the nomination to the person entitled thereunder.
- 40. Inspection of Books Any ten members of the Society each of whom has been a member of the Society for not less than twelve months immediately preceding the date of the application, may apply to the Registrar in the form prescribed by the Treasury Regulations to appoint an actuary or accountant to inspect the books of the Society and to report thereon pursuant to Section 47 of the Industrial and Provident Societies Act, 1965.
- 41. Inspection of Affairs It shall be the right of one-tenth of the whole number of members, or if the number of members shall at any time exceed 1000, it shall be the right of 100 members, by an application in writing to the Chief Registrar, signed by them in the forms respectively prescribed by the . Treasury Regulations:-
- (a) To apply for the appointment of an inspector or inspectors to examine into the affairs of the Society and to report thereon.
- (b) To apply for the calling of a special meeting of the Society.

XVIII. ARBITRATION

42. Arbitration - In case any dispute arises between the Society of any of its officers and any member or persons claiming on account of a member or under the rules, or, in case of any complaint against any member, application may be made to the Committee for redress, and should the Committee not bring the parties to agreement, the matter in dispute shall be submitted to the arbitration of three persons, one appointed by each of the parties concerned, and the third by the Governors of the Federation of Agricultural Co-operatives. The award of the Arbitrators shall be final, and the costs of such arbitration shall be borne by the disputing parties in such proportion as the arbitrators may determine. In this rule the word "members" includes any person aggrieved who has for not more than six months ceased to be a member.

XIX. DISSOLUTION OF THE SOCIETY

43. Dissolution of the Society - The Society may at any time be dissolved by the consent of three-fourths of the members, present or by proxy, testified by the Treasury Regulations, or by winding up in manner provided by the Industrial And Provident Societies Acts.

XX. COPIES OF RULES

44. Copies of Rules - It shall be the duty of the Committee of Management to provide the secretary with a sufficient number of copies of the rules, to enable him to deliver to any person on demand a copy of such rules on payment of a sum not exceeding ten pence and of the secretary to deliver such copies accordingly.

XXI. AMENDMEN'T OF RULES

45. Mode of amending Rules - The rules may be amended by resolution of a three-fourths majority of the members present or by proxy at a Special General Meeting. No amendment of rules is valid until registered.

Ponders End & District Smallholders Association Limited (the Association)

We as members of the Association have grave concerns about the affairs of the Association, and in particular: (1) contravention by the Committee of Management ("the Committee") of the Association's Rule Book ("the Rule Book") and of the Co-operative and Community Benefit Society Act 2014 ("the 2014 Act"); and (2) in connection with the failure of the Committee to bring parties engaged in a matter of dispute to agreement.

We refer to the Rule Book which constitutes and governs the Association and to the 2014 Act which governs co-operative societies, community benefit societies and other societies registered or treated as registered under the Industrial and Provident Societies Act 1965, and applies to the Association.

We require that the Committee provide to us within 7 days of receipt of this letter the items listed below, failing which we will instruct solicitors to commence legal proceedings as provided under the 2014 Act.

- 1. We require confirmation in writing from you that a full, independent audit of the Association's accounts for the accounting years to end of December 2012 and end of December 2013 will be undertaken in the next 7 days, providing details of the independent auditors, and that the resulting audits be provided to all members of the Association within 14 days of receipt by the Committee.
- 2. We require confirmation in writing from you that the following are available for inspection and properly maintained, in respect of the accounting years 2009 to present:
 - all statements of the Association's bank accounts;
 - all records in respect of the Allotments Account, the Clubhouse Account, the Trading Hut Account, and the separate Bank Account operated by Committee members for the purpose of dealing with raffles and other similar monies (all as referred to in the 2013 Statements);
 - all records of the Association in respect of expenditure on wages and related tax and national insurance;
 - all records of the Association in respect of rental income;
 - all records of the Association relating as applicable to:

- o open days;
- kids days;
- other fundraising;
- all records of the Association in respect of accounting for VAT on bar income;
- all records showing the breakdown of bar income, relating as applicable to:
 - o the bar itself;
 - o slot-machine;
 - o pool table;
 - o non-members charge for use of the bar.
- 3. We require a copy of a notice to be addressed to all plotholders of the Association from the Committee, giving notice of a Special General Meeting of the Association, to be convened and held as a result of the attached requisition of members of the Association.

In the absence of a full and proper response to the above requests applications will be duly made to the Financial Conduct Authority ("the FCA") under the 2014 Act to:

- appoint an accountant or actuary to inspect the Association's books and to report on them;
- to appoint one or more inspectors to examine into and report on the Association's affairs; and
- to call a special meeting of the Association.

In order to inform you fully of our rights, we set out below the relevant provisions of the Rule Book and the 2014 Act, pursuant to which officers of the Committee have statutory duties, may be found guilty of certain statutory offences, and are subject to certain powers of the members of the Association.

The Committee, in conducting the business of the Association has a number of statutory duties under the 2014 Act relating to the keeping of proper books and accounts, these are:

- a duty to send to the FCA within the period of 7 months beginning immediately after the end of a year of account (a) a return relating to its affairs for that year; (b) a copy of each balance sheet made during that year; and (c) a copy of any relevant auditor's report for that year. The annual return must contain the Association's revenue account for that year and a balance sheet as at the end of that year (Section 89). This is incorporated under XIV, 37(a)(i) of the Rule Book:
 - Under VIII, 19 of the Rule Book, the audited accounts shall be submitted at the Annual General Meeting of the Association;
- (b) a duty to appoint one or more qualified auditors in each year of account to audit its accounts and balance sheet for that year, unless the Association is a "small society". The 2013 Statements show that the Association is not a small society (Section 83):

- Under X, 30 a qualified auditor shall be appointed at the Annual General Meeting of the Association;
- (c) a duty to give a copy of its latest annual return, free of charge, to any member or person interested in the Association's funds who asks for it (Section 90). This is incorporated under XIV, 37(a)(ii) of the Rule Book;
- (d) a duty to display at all times a copy of its latest balance sheet in a conspicuous position at its registered office (Section 81.) This is incorporated under XIV, 37(a)(iii) of the Rule Book;
- (e) a duty to keep proper books of account with respect to its transactions and its assets and liabilities, including a duty to ensure that such books: (a) give a true and fair view of the state of the Association's affairs and (b) explain its transactions and a duty to establish and maintain a satisfactory system of control of its books of account, cash holdings and receipts and remittances (Section 75);
- (f) a duty to prepare in each year of account (a) a revenue account for that year which deals with the Association's affairs as a whole, or (b) two or more revenue accounts for that year which deal separately with particular businesses carried on by the Association (Sections 79 and 80);
 - Under IV 11(a) of the Rule Book, there shall be kept a General Account of the Association in respect of the general business of the Association which is defined at I, 4 of the Rule Book ("the General Account");
 - Under IV A 11(b) of the Rule Book, there must be kept a separate Small Holdings and Allotments Account in respect of all income and expenditure of the business of creating or promoting the creation of small holdings or allotments (the "Allotments Account");
 - Under VIII 26 of the Rule Book, the business and management of the Association's Club House shall be conducted by a Committee of Management of the Club House;
- (g) an officer of the Association who receives or is in charge of money, or an employee of the Association who receives or is in charge of money and is not engaged under a special agreement to account, must render such an account as the Association or its Committee may require (a) at such time as the relevant person is required to do so by the Rule Book, (b) on demand, or (c) on notice in writing requiring the relevant person to do so, given or left at that person's last or usual place of residence (Section 42.)

Any member of the Committee, in conducting the business of the Association may be found guilty of certain statutory offences under the 2014 Act, these are:

- 1. **General offences**: a person commits an offence if he (a) fails to do anything (including giving a notice or sending a return or other document) that the person is by this Act required to do, (b) fails to allow anything to be done that the person is by this Act required to allow to be done, (c) wilfully neglects or refuses to do any act, or to provide any information, required for the purposes of this Act by the FCA or PRA or by any other person authorised under this Act (d) does anything forbidden by this Act, or (e) makes a return required by this Act, or wilfully provides information required by this Act, that is in any respect false or insufficient (Section 127.)
- 2. **Misappropriation of the Association's property**: a person who, (1) by false representation or deception, and with fraudulent intent, obtains possession of any property of a registered society commits an offence, and (2) has any property of a registered society in the person's possession commits an offence if, with fraudulent intent, the person (a) withholds or misapplies the property, or (b) wilfully applies any

part of the property to purposes which are not authorised by the Association's rules or which are not in accordance with this Act (Section 130.)

The Committee, in conducting the business of the Association is subject to certain powers of the members of the Association provided under the 2014 Act, these are:

- 1. a duty to give a copy of its registered rules to any person who asks for them and pays such fee as the Association may require but no fee is payable where the request is made by a member of the Association who has not previously been given a copy of those rules (Section 18) This is incorporated under XX, 44 of the Rule Book;
- 2. on the application of at least 10 qualifying members of the Association, the FCA may appoint an accountant or actuary to inspect the Association's books and to report on them (Section 105.) This is incorporated under XVI, 40 of the Rule Book;
- 3. on the application of at least 10% of the Association's members, the FCA may (a) appoint one or more inspectors to examine into and report on the Association's affairs or (b) call a special meeting of the Association (Section 106). This is incorporated under XVI, 41 of the Rule Book.

We await your response to our above requests by 9 March 2015.

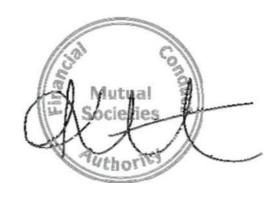

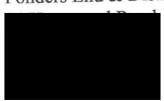

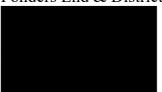

Dear Secretary,

I was appalled by the reception I received from our elected committee members in the Clubhouse on the evening of Thursday 11 August 2016. In particular the unprofessional behaviour of Mr Barnard, the Chair of the Association.

The experience left me in total disbelief and astonishment at the Committee.

You invited me to meet for the opportunity to see the prosecution letters relating to the fine of £1,900 which the FCA levied against our Association. However, within minutes upon arrival my advocate and I were subjected to an extremely hostile reception. The torrent of verbal abuse that we both endured was disgraceful and unprofessional.

My requests to see the documents were repeatedly denied by you and the Committee members. Matters then escalated very quickly resulting in the advocate, who was signed in as my guest, being pushed by the Chair and being told to F^* #k Off. The advocate believed the Chair's behavior was threatening, and warranted the involvement of the Police.

I do not understand why you invited me on two separate occasions to see the letters and then decided at the appointed time of 8pm to tell me that the "viewing meeting" had been cancelled. Furthermore there is no secrecy to the fact that you have the

letters so why should they be kept guarded and out of sight of the plot-holders and associate members?

I was shocked that in your role as Secretary you watched another female member who was calmly reciting the advice, given in a letter from the FCA to an aggrieved member, being subjected to intolerable behavior by the Chair. You did nothing to alleviate the situation.

My attempts to engage in conversation with you to grant me access to the documents was constantly hampered by the actions and remarks made by the Chair and by the raised voices of some of the other members present.

This behaviour is not acceptable in our Association. If individuals of our elected Committee treat others with disrespect then they should be expelled from the Association forthwith.

Members have a democratic right to see information that may have an impact on the financial viability of PEDSA.

Plot holders have made several attempts over the past couple of years to seek the Committee's counsel and to discuss matters relating to the affairs of the Association. The response has ranged from poor to non-existent, members have been shouted down at AGMs, letters have been ignored, and meetings arranged which were then cancelled at the last minute with no prior notice.

I am therefore requesting on behalf of the plot holders that, under our constitutional right, you let me have copies of the prosecution letters.

Finally I would like to emphasise to the officers of our Association the seriousness of their refusal to grant our request. They could be held personally liable for any repercussions relating to their non compliance.

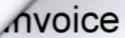

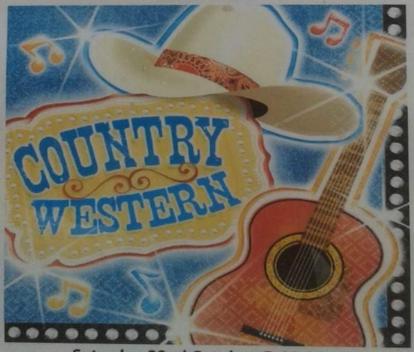
