Cabinet agreed:

- 1. To recommend to Council to approve the additional budget as set out in part 2 of the report to complete the two sites with Kier as set out in part 2 of the report and terminate the Development Agreement on terms including to complete Phase 1 for the additional sums set out in part 2 of the report.
- 2. To delegate authority to the Executive Director Regeneration and Environment and the Executive Director Finance, Resources and Customer Services to conclude the details of the termination agreement referred to in 1. above. This will take into consideration the revised fixed price contract sum for partial completion of the Development Agreement in respect of completing 47 homes on three sites at St Georges, Parsonage Lane and Tudor Crescent only (Phase 1) as part of a negotiated commercial settlement.
- 3. To recommend to Council, subject to the Development Agreement being terminated with Kier, to approve the recommended procurement options as set out in part 2 of the report for Phase 2 (Holtwhites Hill, Jasper Close, Forty Hill and Lavender Hill).
- 4. To recommend that Council approves the additional budget required for Phase 2, as set in part 2 of the report.
- 5. The recommendations set out in the part 2 report which contain exempt information, with an addition to recommendation 2.3 agreed at the Cabinet meeting.
