<p>AGREED: that the following decision will come into effect on Monday 18 September 2017, subject to not being called in:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The London Borough of Enfield continues contractual discussions with a view to regularising current delivery arrangements for public health children's services as soon as possible. 2. That the interim contract is directly awarded for a period of 18 months to secure continuity of service whilst allowing sufficient time to fully re-procure the services. 3. The development of the content of these contractual arrangements to be delegated to the Director of Public Health and the Assistant Director of Legal Services. 							
<p>ALTERNATIVE OPTIONS CONSIDERED:</p> <p>Development of contractual arrangements between Enfield Council and a service provider are considered the only option to maintain a mandated safeguarding service.</p>							
<p>REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATIONS:</p> <p>Previous contractual arrangements for NHS England CCG as Commissioner have expired and have not provided as previously anticipated a suitable framework for ongoing contractual relationship and a full procurement is needed. This will take 18 months to complete satisfactorily which means that an interim solution is necessary. There is a need to secure continuity of service for this period and the risk of not implementing interim contractual arrangements are such that direct award is recommended.</p>
