On 26th January 2018 your premises was searched for counterfeit and non-duty paid alcohol and tobacco. Officers also checked the premises for cigarettes and tobacco that did not comply with standardised packaging legislation. The following items were found and seized;

Non-duty paid:

15 x Marlboro (20 pack);
11 x Davidoff (20 pack);
3 x Karelia (20 pack);
3 x Parliament (20 pack)

On 7th February 2018 Licensing Enforcement Officers visited the premises to carry out a full licence inspection. You advised that you are now the owner of the premises and that you would be submitting a Transfer Application and Vary DPS application once you have your Personal licence. The Transfer application has since been received. The following conditions were not being complied with:

Condition 3 – Unable to find training records
Condition 6 – Unable to find Refusals Book
Condition 7 - Only one member of staff on premises at time of visit.
Condition 11 – CCTV – time out by 5 minutes
Condition 12 - Incident log book not available
Condition 13 - No can marking system in place (if you wish to have this condition removed from the licence you will need to apply for a full licence variation).
Advised to send evidence to officers.

A revisit was carried out on 16th February 2018. Two people were working at the premises but other than that the same issues remained. You were again asked to email evidence of

compliance to Officer.

On 21st February 2018 evidence of the training and refusals were received.

Conditions must be complied with at all times. Failing to comply with any condition attached to a Premises Licence is a criminal offence, which on conviction is punishable by an unlimited maximum fine, up to six months imprisonment or both.

In relation to the non-duty paid good, please consider this letter to be a warning as to your future conduct. Should further similar offences be committed at the premises, the Licensing Authority shall take immediate action to have the premises licence permanently revoked and or to prosecute you.

You must buy tobacco, alcohol and any other branded product from a reputable seller. These products must be evidenced by receipts which must be available for inspection upon request.
