<p>AGREED: that the following decision will come into effect on 22 January 2018, subject to not being called in:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> To note the issues raised in response to the statutory consultation and the officer responses set out in Section 6 of the report To approve a maximum expenditure of £200,000 to enable the scheme (illustrated on the drawing in appendix 1 of the report) to be implemented, including making the necessary traffic management orders without modification. 							
<p>ALTERNATIVE OPTIONS CONSIDERED:</p> <p>The following alternative option has been considered: Not implementing the scheme – This is not recommended as this would prevent a safe continuous connection between Enfield Town and Edmonton Green. This option would therefore reduce the anticipated benefits from the development of a cycling network. Facilities that will improve pedestrian safety would also be lost.</p>							
<p>REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATIONS:</p> <p>The recommendations have been made to enable the scheme to be implemented so that a number of benefits can be realised including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Unlocking an east-west sustainable transport route between the two major shopping/employment/transport/residential hubs at Enfield Town and Edmonton Green. Enabling increased levels of physical activity by providing the infrastructure to encourage more people to make short journeys by foot or by bike instead of by car.
