The LGA has estimated that councils face a funding gap of£7.8billion by 2025 – just to maintain current service levels. By 2020, the Government will have cut a staggering £16 billion from core funding since 2010. Here in Enfield, the Government has cut £161 million from our funding since 2010 with yet more to come. These massive cuts threaten Enfield Council's ability to deliver the services that the people of Enfield, whether residents or running businesses, expect and deserve. This Council believes that this punitive action by the Government against local authorities shows a callous disregard for the young, sick, elderly and vulnerable who rely on council services to have a decent guality of life. This Council supports the LGA campaign –

Moving the Conversation On – to build the case for long-term, sustained investment in local government as the way forward to restore Enfield and other councils to a strong and stable financial footing.
