

### **IP75 Additional Representation**

As a response to the Fancy Fair Licence Application and Plan please find attached my further objections below. These objections also represent the objections of the 3 other members of the household. They are xxxxxxxxxxxx.

- The site has car parking for only a few cars near the Bramley Road squash court. This means that the number of people wanting to park in the surrounding streets will result in a horrendous amount of congestion and quite frankly chaos, and no number of road closures is going to solve this problem.

- As a follow on from the above, this type of event needs to be held at Trent Park where the 51st State Festival is successfully held each year, and crucially Trent Park also has 2 large car parks on site. Trent Park is such an obvious choice and only up the road so why can this event not be held there instead?

- There is no stipulation around what specific plan is in place to ensure 'prevention and vigilance in illegal drug use'.

- In terms of staff who are trained in dealing with customers to use the areas in an orderly and respectful manner, there is no indication of what ratio of staff to customers there is, and what training they will have had.

- More generally there is no indication of staff to customer ratio across all aspects of this proposed event, and with the exception of the catering staff what specific training and qualifications any of the staff have.

- Most alarmingly there is no specific mention of security staff at the event.

- Where it says 'where thought necessary electronic wands will be used to check for illegal drugs', what constitutes the criteria for "where thought necessary"? Surely everyone should be checked?

- From the application there is only 1 Health and Safety Adviser employed to monitor noise and make sure residents leave quietly. One Health and Safety Advisor for up to 10,000 people. Are they serious??

- Overall, the application lacks so much key information it beggars belief how it has got even this far. In addition, a typed application needs to be submitted to show a minimum level of seriousness and professionalism and especially because this scribbled writing is practically impossible to read.

Please do the right thing and reject this application with immediate effect, so that no more of the local residents' or council's time is wasted on this.
