- 3. Agreed that the Director for Adult Social Care, in agreement with the Director of the CCG, to make minor amendments throughout the year to the schemes and funding arrangements to reflect any change in circumstances.

- 2. Approve, for recommendation to Council, the inclusion of the Street Lighting Project in the Council's approved Capital Programme at a cost of £6.375m.
- 3. Approve, for recommendation to Council, funding arrangements as set out in the report being external borrowing of £6.375m of which there is a five year interest free loan of £4.09m from SALIX.
- 4. Note the updated net savings will be reflected in the Medium Term Financial Plan for 2020/21 and future years.
- 5. Delegate to the Director of Environment and Operational Services, in consultation with the Director of Law and Governance, approval to make any necessary changes to the terms of the Street Lighting PFI contract.

- 1. Agreed a phased approach to in-sourcing the day to day repairs service as detailed in section 3 of the report and note the creation of a multi-disciplinary Operational Board which will report on progress to the Repairs Task Force.
- 2. Approved a mobilisation budget of £1.2 million, allocated over 2 years, funded from HRA repairs reserve
- 3. Noted that a 5 year business plan will come forward as part of the annual HRA budget cycle for 2020/21
- 4. Delegated authority to the Director of Housing and Regeneration to commence procurement and tendering exercises to mobilise 5 year contracts, for compliance works including gas servicing, electrical checks and lift services along with back up responsive repairs services.
