

Proposal to change the Enfield Safer Neighbourhood Board constitution.

Rational: - Safer Neighbourhood boards have been in existence for 5 years and MOPAC have issued new guidance as to their key function and priorities.

I am suggesting that we amend our article 1 to reflect the new guidance.

Current:

This paper sets out how the Safer Neighbourhood Board will work in Enfield, in line with the key aims set out in the MOPAC guidance, which are:

- To ensure communities are more closely involved in problem solving and crime prevention.
- To have a broad remit to reflect MOPAC's broader responsibilities, while respecting the view that local people know best what is needed at local level.
- To have greater reach into local communities and ensure a more frequent refresh of ideas and views.
- To achieve greater coherence between different engagement mechanisms such as Ward Panels, the Independent Advisory Group (IAG), Independent Custody Visitors (ICV) and Neighbourhood Watch.
- To make more efficient use of resources to deliver value for money and target funds at tackling issues of local concern and crime prevention.

Proposed:

1. Introduction

This paper sets out how the Safer Neighbourhood Board will work in Enfield, in line with the key aims set out in the MOPAC guidance, which are:

- enable local engagement with the Police;
- enable local accountability of the Police;
- focus on the Police and Crime Plan key principles and priorities - putting victims first and reducing inequalities; keeping children and young people safe; tackling violence against women and girls and tackling hate crime and intolerance. monitor crime performance and public perceptions (community confidence);
- inform the development of policing priorities in the borough;
- monitor MPS support for the delivery of Cape's (ward panels) and community contact sessions; and:
- engage with Borough Independent Advisory Groups and other local mechanisms (e.g. neighbourhood watch, stop and search community

monitoring groups and CCTV monitoring group) to support and inform their work across the borough.

This would have to be ratified at our next AGM.
