To ensure caseloads were at a reasonable level and that practice improvements were sustained, Cabinet agreed to invest in a new social work team in the child protection service and approve a further:

• £125k investment this year would be funded through risk reserves while the permanent investment of £365k in 2020/21 would be managed through the medium-term financial plan process.
