REJECTION ON A NOTICE: DOST HANE, 77 BOUNCES ROAD, LONDON, N9 8LD

On 6 December 2019 the Licensing Authority received from you, Mrs Songul Aydin, a notification in respect of proposed temporary licensable activities due to take place 23:00 to 03:00 on 24,25,31 December 2019 and 1 January 2020 at Dost Hane, 77 Bounces Road, LONDON, N9 8LD. The licensing authority has received an objection under section 104(2) of the Licensing Act 2003 ("the Act").


The objection which applies is indicated by an "X" in the following table.

You are reminded that under section 136 of the Licensing Act 2003, a person commits an offence if he carries on a licensable activity on or from any premises otherwise than under and in accordance with an authorisation; or if he knowingly allows a licensable activity to be so carried on. A person convicted of such an offence is liable to imprisonment for a term not exceeding six months or to a fine of any amount, or to both.
