the best possible energy efficient, sustainable development, with low carbon emissions, within the available budget. This will establish Enfield Council's commitment to significantly reducing carbon emissions and delivering sustainable homes. If the project is not progressed these benefits will not be realised.

- 5. This proposal contributes to the affordable homes' targets identified in the GLA BCHL programme and meets the 2019/20/21 targets.
- 6. The contract price provides good value for money, taking into account the timescales to achieve the drawdown of grant and development programme.
- 7. The delivery of the site will provide 50 units, plus the possibility of a further 15 pipeline housing units subject to planning approval.
- 8. By entering into construction contract to secure GLA funding this gives the flexibility to negotiate an additional increase in affordable council housing, subject to viability. This will also give the opportunity to review and negotiate the build costs with the appointed contractor.
