## SECTION 2: Notice of forthcoming Key Decisions for which it has not been possible to provide notice

This section lists the Key Decisions that are proposed to be taken by the Council, which require publication in accordance with the Local Government Act 2000. There are two routes that can be followed in this instance to enable a decision to be taken.

## 1. <u>Rule 15 – General Exceptions</u>

This procedure is used in cases when:

- it is not possible to provide the required 28 days' notice of a key decision; but
- it is possible to provide a minimum of 5 working days' notice prior to the decision being taken;

## 2. <u>Rule 16 – Special Urgency</u>

This procedure should only be used in exceptional circumstances where it is not possible to:

- provide the required 28 days' notice prior of a key decision; and
- provide a minimum of 5 working days' notice prior to the decision needing to be taken;

## These decisions will not be eligible for call-in.

## **Reasons for Urgency**

1	There is a rapidly position emerging nationally and the potential spread of the virus was not known earlier. Indeed there is still a great deal of uncertainty both nationally and locally on the spread and the impact on the Council's finances.
2	Based on the government advice about protection vulnerable people by social distancing strategies it is proposed to suspend all social care day centres from Friday. This includes day centres for Older People, People with Learning Disabilities and Mental Health problems. This will include those centres directly managed, managed through IWE and independent sector day service providers we fund.
	Clients will be identified who are at higher risk and provided with support to remain at home. Day centre staff will be re- deployed to check, monitor and support these clients at home where this is necessary. We will keep these arrangements under review.
