SECTION 2: Notice of forthcoming Key Decisions for which it has not been possible to provide notice

This section lists the Key Decisions that are proposed to be taken by the Council, which require publication in accordance with the Local Government Act 2000. The decisions listed are those for which it has not been possible to provide 28 days' notice and need to comply with the Council's urgency procedure. There are two routes that can be followed in this instance to enable a decision to be taken.

1. <u>Rule 15 – General Exceptions</u>

This procedure is used in cases when:

- it is not possible to provide the required 28 days' notice of a key decision; but
- it is possible to provide a minimum of 5 working days' notice prior to the decision being taken;

2. Rule 16 – Special Urgency

This procedure should only be used in exceptional circumstances where it is not possible to:

- provide the required 28 days' notice prior of a key decision; and
- provide a minimum of 5 working days' notice prior to the decision needing to be taken;

These decisions will not be eligible for call-in.

Reasons for Urgency:

In response to Covid-19, face to face services in the civic centre and libraries were closed to the public at the end of March. This report sets out options for reopening critical face to face services when it is safe to do so for customers and for staff, in response to Government guidance. For the purposes of this decision we are assuming the current proposed Government timescales for reopening of public places (indicative date of 4^{th} July) as the potential phased start of face to face services reopening.

This decision is urgent because Government guidance currently suggests an indicative date for reopening of public places as the 4th July. A Cabinet decision prior to that date is needed in order to plan for the potential reopening of face to face services, subject to safety considerations for both customers and for staff.

It was not possible to give the required 28 days notice and include the decision on the Council's Key Decision List because the Government guidance ("Our plan to rebuild: The UK Government's COVID-19 recovery strategy") was set out on the 12 May and has required subsequent work in terms of how we can keep customers and staff safe in our reopening plans.
