Care Home Staff Vaccinations

- Number of care home staff who have received the first jab – 75.3%
- Number of care home staff who have received both jabs - 61.9%
- Number of care home staff left to receive the vaccine – 461



Care Home Residents Vaccinations

- Number of care home residents who have received the first jab – 93.4%
- Number of care home residents who have received both jabs - 88.3%
- Number of care home residents left to receive the vaccine – 83



Arrangement in place to support the vaccine take up

- Staff/team webinars with paid time for staff to attend
- One to one sessions with PH for staff who are hesitant
- Payments to staff for attendance and vaccines for time and travel of £20 per jab
- Twice weekly contact with home managers/deputies to understand reasons for staff hesitancy and follow up calls to support with follow up calls arranged based on themed feedback

Arrangement in place to support the vaccine take up

- One to one support with each home to manage rapid/fast track access to vaccine slots
- Links with the Care Home Assessment Team to arrange in-reach appointments for both staff and residents in care homes
- Key messages through weekly public health messages to care homes including myth busting and frequently asked questions, particularly around vaccinations



Arrangement in place to support the vaccine take up

- BAME focused webinars (for different BAME groups) supported by public health, Health professionals and community leaders
- Messages through provider forums with clear messaging that Council/families would not choose to make referrals to care homes with low vaccine uptake
- Improvements & Standards Manager continues to visit to address Covid related issues.



Ways Vaccinations Have Resulted In Positive Change In Enfield.

On the 19th June – **26** "Cases" of Coronavirus were reported in LBE. During the "2nd Wave" in early spring on 13th February **23** Cases of Coronavirus were reported in Enfield. Despite the similar number of cases the difference made by the success of the vaccination regime can be seen below:

Ways Vaccinations Have Resulted In Positive Change In Enfield.

- In the week ending 12.02.2021 19 people died in Enfield from Coronavirus. In the week ending 11.06.2021 one person died in Enfield with Coronavirus.
- On 22.06.2021 not one resident of an Enfield Residential Home had either suspected or confirmed COVID-19.
- Weekly number of cases in residents aged over 65 have decreased from 55 on 13th Feb to 5 on 20th June
- 47% of cases on 20th June had symptoms vs. 53% of cases reported on 13th Feb
