

Stage 1: Trigger, Screen & Assess

- Expression of Interest form received
- Application logged
- High level assessment of feasibility
- Diagnose the extent of the issues, establish the level of commitment from School, engage with other Council services (e.g. Parking Services, Traffic & Transport, Education) to gather any other relevant information.

Is the site feasible?

- School notified and site recorded as not suitable for a School Street closure. Alternative options to be explored.

Yes

- School notified that their application has been received and initial assessment undertaken
- Details logged with other future schools until funding is made available
- School to continue / commence Stars Journey with support of council

Stage 2: Prioritization

Schools with EOI's ranked against current Selection Criteria:

- Commitment to STARS, number of pupils, staff car park location
- Access to public transport, Enfield Poverty and Inequality Commission Report, overall ward balance
- Traffic impact assessment, number of closure points required, number of households in the zone, impact on businesses in the zone

Is the school still interested?

- School logged as no longer wishing to move forward with reasons documented
- Schools may still be contacted in the future as further opportunities become available

Stage 3: Funding & Implementation

- Memorandum of Understanding entered between the School and Council to work in partnership to develop the School Street (confirm continued STARS commitment)
- Funding secured for delivery
- Develop designs in collaboration with the School
- Deliver appropriate consultation and approval process
- Implement the School Street
