Until such time as the Business and Planning Act 2020 comes into force, tables and chairs licences will be issued as temporary street trading licences under the under the existing London Local Authorities Act 1990 with a fee set at £100. The period to determine the licence application will be the same as the Business and Planning Act 2020 (14 calendar days) and licences run to 30 September 2021 with the same standard licence conditions as per Appendix A.</li> <li>2. Approval of the licence application fee of £100 (maximum permitted in the Act) for pavement licences under the Business and Planning Act 2020.</li> <li>3. | The Act comes into force after 20 July 2020, but provision is made under the existing legislation on the same terms of the Act to allow tables and chairs licences before this. This is so that business can secure these licences in time for the summer.
