Background

- Base Case as part of Countryside bid for M1 (£350K)
- Countryside now Contributing £400K
- Council enhancements for Budget of £1.2 M
- Planning consent received
- Building handed over to the Council end of Feb 2023
- MLP procured. CONEL now into contract
- Links to Council's children's hup and JCP established
- Seeking commitment from developers and their supply chains to take on trainees

Features of the MLP Tender

- Management contract, maximum 5 years
- Must be on Mayors Construction Academy list of Training providers
- Must be or must partner with an approved Apprenticeship Training Agency
- Assessed on a 80% Quality 15% Income and 5% capital Investment in the building

- Practical Completion of the Skills Academy Done
- Commercial deal with CONEL Done
- Lease with CONEL Done
- Fit out complete by CONEL 17th April
- Trainees expected to be on site after April /after the Easter Holidays




Troubadour Skills Academy Objectives
